CYBERUK 2017

As the threat advances and cyber security landscape evolves, so must the events that facilitate vital discussion within the sector.

CYBERUK 2017 will be the National Cyber Security Centre's inaugural Flagship event, combining GCHQ's IA and Cyber Security Flagship and the relaunched CYBERUK In Practice events to create a single agenda-shaping conference.

This event will play a vital role in the coming year's cyber security calendar, providing a forum for debate, discussion and sharing ideas and experience. Content will be responsive and influenced by participants' views and feedback,

which will be given in a highly interactive and participative environment.

The CYBERUK events will present an annual platform to survey the cyber landscape, identify progress achieved and focus on priorities in the year ahead. It is the Government's main briefing opportunity for those involved in operational security and who develop and implement Cyber Security and IA across Government and industry.



CYBERUK STRATEGY

The IA and Cyber Security Flagship event has been rebranded CYBERUK Strategy and will be held on Day One of CYBERUK 2017. This is the Government's primary conference for briefing 800+ cyber security and IA leaders from across Government, Critical National Infrastructure and industry. Minister-led, it will feature the Director GCHQ and be chaired by Ciaran Martin, CEO National Cyber Security Centre. This is the leadership event for the information security sector. It will also feature a Networking Dinner at Liverpool's historic St George's Hall.



CYBERUK IN PRACTICE

Days Two and Three of CYBERUK 2017 will encompass CYBERUK In Practice. This event brings together information security and technology professionals at all levels from across the public sector, CNI and industry. This will include specialists in the design and development of online services and systems, procurement and all areas of ICT delivery. It will be an invaluable opportunity for networking and exchanging experience and technical insights, updates and engagement over the cyber security challenges we all face. Widely acclaimed earlier this year, it will be attended by 1,000+ participants.

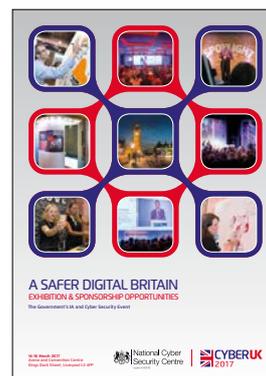


WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

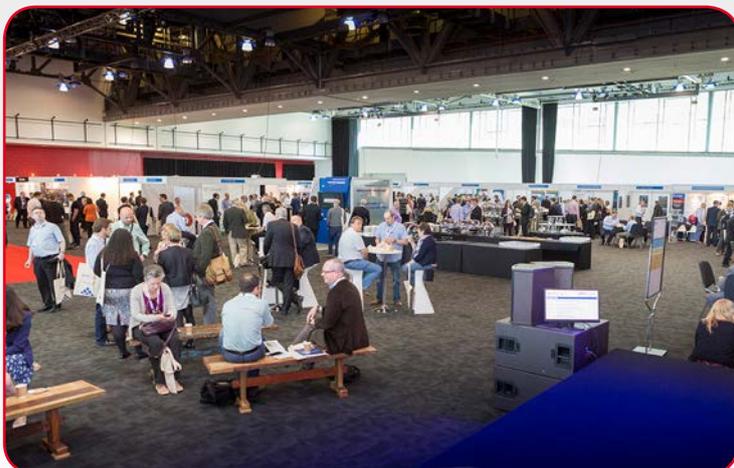
